## National Vaccine Network Update – Effective December 1, 2022

We are happy to announce that, effective December 1, 2022, the national vaccine network will provide coverage inside and outside of the CareFirst regional service area for all Individual, Small Group and Large Group CareFirst members with pharmacy benefits. All major pharmacies are in the national vaccine network including CVS, Rite Aid, Walgreens, Giant, Walmart and more.

The following vaccines are covered:

- COVID-19
- Flu
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Pneumonia
- Shingles
- Meningococcal (meningitis)
- MMR (measles, mumps and rubella)
- Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis—also known as whooping cough)
- Td (booster vaccine for tetanus and diphtheria)

### Important reminders

Members should:

- Check with the pharmacy to determine whether a prescription or doctor's order is required for any of these vaccines.
- Check their benefit plan to determine whether they are responsible for any copays or deductibles.
- Let their doctor know they received the vaccine at their next visit.
